PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION POLICY

What data do we collect?

We collect personal data such as:

Why we collect your information?

We use your data to:

How do we protect your data?

We implement appropriate security measures to protect your data, including the use of technology and restricted access to information.

To whom do we share your data?

We only share your data with tourism service providers (airlines, hotels, etc.) and competent authorities when it is necessary to fulfil our services and legal obligations.

How long do we keep your data?

We keep your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, or until you request its deletion.

Your rights.

- Oppose the use of your data for marketing purposes.
